

THE SEWING WORKSHOP

Mitered Tamari Apron

Cutting Instructions

3 coordinating fabrics are used for this apron

Piece 1: Apron	(fabric A)	33½" x 32½"
Piece 2: Band	(fabric B)	6" x 44"
Piece 3: Band	(fabric C)	6" x 44"
Piece 4: Pocket	(fabric B)	13½" x 11½"
Piece 5: Short Tie	(fabric C)	5½" x 37"
Piece 6: Long Tie	(fabric B)	5½" x 44"
Piece 7: Loop	(fabric B)	1½" x 8"

½" seam allowances are included.

Order of Construction

Refer to the schematic on page 2 of this document for overall design and layout.

Orient the main Apron piece per the schematic on page 2 with the widest width (33 ½") horizontal to you.

Mitered Frame

Refer to pages 6 and 7 in *Mastering Miters* for detailed instructions on how to make a Mitered Frame. Please note the starting and stopping points in steps 1, 2, and 4.

Sew Band piece 2 to the right hand side of Apron piece 1.

Sew Band piece 3 to the bottom edge of Apron piece 1.

Complete the bottom right hand corner miter of Bands 2 and 3 - see page 7 of *Mastering Miters*.

The diagonal miter does not need to be finished since it is on the bias.

Serge finish the two seams together and press towards the Bands.

Hems

The hem widths on this apron differ from the hems sewn in the Tamari Apron instructions. The top, right hand side and bottom hems have 1 ½" hem allowances with 1" finished hems. Use a 1 ½"-wide template to press the first fold of the hem under. Use a 1"-wide template to press the finished hem in place. The left hand side has a 2 1/2"-wide hem allowance and a 2" finished hem. Use 2 ½" and 2"-wide templates to prepare this hem.

Topstitch all four hems.

Corner Miters

Each corner is finished using a miter.

Corners B and C have 45° miters. See pages 3 and 4 in *Mastering Miters* for instructions to sew these miters.

Corners A and D have asymmetric miters. See page 5 in *Mastering Miters* for instructions to sew these miters.
