Downloading

Once your order is complete, you will receive an email with more downloading information. The subject of this email is **Download - Info**. This email will contain a link to download your pattern. An example of the email is below:

Hi (Customer Name),

the file(s) you ordered are ready for your download.

Please enter the following Download-ID(s) in our Downloads Area:

The direct link will take you to our website, a page labeled **Download Area. Your Download ID (shown in red) should be automatically entered. Click **Start Download**.

*The url (shown in blue) should contain a direct link to your download. If not, please highlight the entire url, copy, then paste into your web browser.

**If Download ID doesn't appear automatically, enter the ID manually.

Printing

Our ePatterns, instructions and pattern, are formatted in a PDF file. Use Adobe Reader or Adobe Acrobat to open and print pattern. If you don't already have it, you can download the updated version here.

All patterns are full-scale with all sizes included. Each pattern prints on letter-size paper, 8.5" x 11" sheets.

Printing Specifics:

- Do Not Scale to Fit, Do Not Crop, Print Scale at 100%
- No Additional Borders

Test Square:

Each printed page will have a number, starting with 1. On Page 1 you will find a Test Square that will measure 1" x 1", 2.5 x 2.5 cm. Measure this square to ensure accurate printing size.

Pattern Assembly

Every pattern includes a **Page Assembly Guide**. Think of this guide as a map to help you piece each page together to create your pattern. Use this guide to tape each sheet together.

Each page has a **Margin** box for alignment, part of which will be trimmed. See *Order of Assembly*.

*Tip: Think of your pattern in rows and columns. Tape your pages together in rows from left to right (ie. Pages 1-5, 6-10, 11-15).

Order of Assembly:

- Trim along right-hand margins of all pages
- Tape together each row starting at the top (eShrug & eVest have 3 rows)
- Trim along bottom margins
- Tape together each row (ie. Row/Pages 1-5 *tape to* Row/Pages 6-10, Row/Pages 6-10 *tape to* Row/Pages 11-15)
- Cut out pattern along desired size
- Enjoy!
